Hints and tips. When working a model which will be placed on a polystyrene dummy put a square of parchment paper between the model and the polystyrene this prevents the polystyrene from making marks on the paste, stops colouring dusts from staining the dummy and also makes it easier to turn the model around on the dummy avoiding finger marks or mis shaping the model.
