She used a 5 in sponge cake, crumb-coated it with white chocolate ganache and then used moulds and sugar paste to create both a bark effect and circle effect to turn the cake into a tree stump. Karen also used the Katy Sue mushroom mould to make various mushrooms to decorate the cake. The cake was airbrushed and dusted. We learned how to use an airbrush effectively and also how to decorate a cake which looked really good without having to worry about the icing being perfectly smooth. This is a really good cake for beginners and adaptable for lots of occasions!

July meeting. Hope you will join us in July for Georgie Godbold who is doing a footballer wobbly. Georgie is always very entertaining and usually brings along a selection of her wobblies for us to admire.
